TAKE COVER (Taken from <u>Coffee Break with God</u>, pg. 124-125)

"He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings you may seek refuge. His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark." - (Psalm 91:4 NASB)

Bouncing back from disappointment, loss, or an irritating situation can take time. When you're hurting, the thing you need to do is nurse your wounds for a little while, regroup, then go back out and face the world.

Wouldn't it be nice if that saying we learned as children was true in our lives today — "I'm rubber, you're glue. Everything you say bounces off me and sticks to you"? What a relief it would be if angry words, dirty looks, and cruel actions had no power to hurt us.

Many of us have frying pans coated with Teflon, because food doesn't stick to it. The scientists at Dow Chemical have come up with what might be called the next generation of Teflon: a fluorocarbon formula that can be sprayed or brushed onto a surface. It's been suggested it might be used to repel graffiti on subway walls, to ward off barnacles on ships, dirt on wallpaper, and ice on aircraft. This substance is actually an adhesive and an abhesive. Its "base" sticks to whatever it's applied to, but its "surface" repels moisture.

This is a little like being in the world, but not of it. "I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from evil," Jesus prayed for His disciples in John 17:15-16 (KJV). "As thou has sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world" (v. 18).

We have to come into contact with a lot of negatives throughout our lives, but we don't have to absorb them or let them become part of us. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we can stick to God. Then His presence and power in our lives will not allow us to be coated with anything that will drag us down.
