- 4. **Practice Persistence** "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful." (Hebrews 10:23)
- 5. **Practice Anticipation** "I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:14)

I hope that we all can learn to put all of these child-like characteristics into practice in our own spiritual lives. Thank you again to all who helped with, attended, and supported VBS!
