OUR VALUE

According to the Federal Reserve website, the following is how much it costs to produce currency in 2017:

DENOMINATION	COST OF PRODUCTION	
\$1 and \$2	5.4 cents per note	
\$5	11. 5 cents per note	
\$10	10.9 cents per note	
\$20	12.2 cents per note	
\$50	19.4 cents per note	
\$100	15.5 cents per note	

It is amazing to me how insignificant the cost is to produce money in comparison to each bill's value. For instance, a 100 dollar bill is worth \$99.845 more than what it costs to produce it. Why?

Why is a 100 dollar bill worth \$100? It isn't because of the ink. It isn't because of the materials. It isn't because of the picture on it. It is worth \$100, because somebody with authority has said that it is worth \$100. You probably wouldn't even want a 100 dollar bill if there wasn't someone saying that it had that value. It's worth in materials is very insignificant.

What is our worth? What is our value? We can often times look at ourselves and wonder what our value is. With the poor decisions that we have made, the things that have happened to us, and everything we have done; we can look at ourselves and determine that there isn't much value.

However, our value is not determined by the things that have come to make up who we are. Rather, our value is determined by One who has the authority to determine that value. We are created in the image of God - (Genesis 1:27). We are fearfully and wonderfully made - (Psalm 139:14). And our value has been determined - "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." - (John 3:16).

Our value is not determined by the decisions and events of our lives. Our value is not in our make up. Our value is in the One who made us and has the authority to say that we are valuable. He has determined our value to be so great, that He gave His only Son for us!
