CHAMBERLAIN OUTREACH

We would like to continue our efforts to support Chamberlain Elementary in our community this coming school year. The vision behind this effort is to reach out to our community by partnering with this local school, with a larger goal of reaching the lost through serving, getting to know them, and finally inviting them into our church family.

For those that may not be aware, there are opportunities to serve at the school by tutoring, volunteering to help during lunch, and reading in the classrooms. As in the past two years, we will continue to provide a luncheon once per month to the teachers and staff (about 20-25 people) on "early out/faculty senate" days. Several people who have prepared food for the meals in the past have said they would like to continue. Food can be dropped off at the church building or taken directly to the school. Only two or three people are needed for set-up. The luncheon simply involves delivery and set-up of the food at the school on one Friday each month around 10:30 a.m. (This usually takes about 20-30 minutes from picking up the food at the church to setting up the meal at the school.) The teachers/staff serve themselves and are so appreciative. It would be great if we could have more people contributing food items for the meals; then those providing food would only need to participate a few times throughout the year. Grace Wagner and I will coordinate the luncheons this year. Please let one of us know if you would be willing to occasionally provide a food item, if you are interested in serving at the school in one of the other areas, and please feel free to share your thoughts on this outreach.

Stephen has offered some good ideas, such as focusing on the two fifth grade classes this year. Perhaps we could help with the needs of their classroom and find more ways to get to know the fifth-grade students. Teachers often find themselves providing classroom/student materials at their own expense, maybe we can help in the fifth grade classrooms. Another idea is to hold some events for the fifth graders along with the children in our church throughout the year such as a "movie/game night." Last year we dedicated a Sunday service with a dinner afterward on two occasions -- once to honor the teachers and staff and another to celebrate the fifth-grade graduates (in an effort to invite them into our church). Maybe this could be combined into one celebration at the end of the year. **We welcome any ideas to make the outreach more successful.** We will continue giving updates on any new ideas that are suggested or implemented. I spoke with the principal, Phoebe McCloud, about this coming year and she is very excited and appreciative of any way we can continue to partner with the school.

Thank you to those who have supported this effort in the past, and thank you in advance to anyone willing to help out this year! Let's be the hands and feet of Jesus. What better way to reach out in service than through the education of the children in our community!
