## THE QUIET CHAIR

At my son's preschool, the teachers have a "quiet chair." The quiet chair is for when a child is getting a little bit chaotic and loud for the space they are in. They are asked to sit down, take a few breaths, and remember where they are before returning to play. It isn't necessarily a punishment, it is just a way to help a child to calm down before they get to the point of needing to be punished. It is a good safeguard that has been put in place to help a child correct their path before they do something they shouldn't.

What is your "quiet chair?" Every day, we get caught up in the hustle and bustle of life. Life gets noisy and chaotic with the sounds of work, school, bills, cleaning, sports, shopping, church, and everything else. Though none of these things are in anyway bad, they can tend to cause our life to seem too loud for the space we are in. When life is too loud and we are too caught up in the everyday issues of life, it can become quite difficult to listen to the Teacher.

So, what is your "quiet chair?" Where are you going and what are you doing to calm down and take a few breaths before life spins you too far out of control?

The psalmist encouraged us to employ the same safeguard against punishment by writing: "Be still, and know that I am God." - (Psalm 46:10).

"Be still" - Sit down in the quiet chair!

"Know that I am God" - Remember that, even though we are caught up in the noise of this world, we need to keep our ears open to listen to the Teacher.

I want to challenge you to find a few moments every day to sit down in the "quiet chair". It's not a bad place to be. Sit in the "quiet chair," take a few breaths, and remember where you are - under the watchful eye and in the loving arms of the Great Teacher!
