### Do the Extraordinary!

I have a book in my office entitled: <u>Extraordinary Uses for Ordinary Things</u>. Reader's Digest published the book with the claim, "2,317 Ways to Save Money and Time." It is really quite an interesting book. Here are some examples that you might enjoy:
