“Amazing Grace”

One of my favorite hymns of all time is “Amazing Grace.” I think it is a beautiful message, with a beautiful story behind it. Through the years I have sung this song in many different ways with many different people. I have sung the song fast, I have sung the song slow. I have sung all of the verses, but more often I have sung just the 1st, 2nd, and last verse. I have even sung the song to many different tunes such as: to the tune of the “Gilligan’s Island” theme song as well as the Eagles “Peaceful Easy Feeling”. It is just an absolutely beautiful song with a beautiful message.

But some time ago I learned that John Newton, the writer of the song, wrote another verse that we don’t often hear. In our song books, “Amazing Grace” (#36) has six verses. That is a fairly long song by our standards! But our song books don’t even include this other verse that Newton wrote. So, I thought I would share that verse with you this week, in hopes that we can appreciate more fully God’s “Amazing Grace!”

The earth shall soon dissolve like snow,

the sun forbear to shine;

But God, Who called me here below,

shall be forever mine.

When we know we have our hope set on God, then we can enjoy the riches of God that we talked about this past Sunday. “I know your tribulation and your poverty (**but you are rich**) ...” (Revelation 2:9a) What a blessing it is, that in a temporary world, we can enjoy the “Amazing Grace” of an eternal God! The “Amazing Grace” of an eternal God is the only treasure we need!


