DEACON UPDATE

Dear Church Family,

We want to give an update on the deacon selection process. We hope that you have been and will continue to be in prayer for this process as we strive to place Godly servants in these positions. We want to thank you for your prayerful consideration and all of you who have put forth nominations.

Over the past several weeks, the elders have been meeting with those nominees and reviewing those conversations. Those meetings are now complete, and the leadership is ready to place a list of men before the congregation to be considered as potential deacons. The elders feel that these men fit the qualifications set out for deacons in (1 Timothy 3:8-13). These men are already showing themselves to be servants and have indicated a desire and willingness to serve in a deacon capacity in this church.

The men that the elders are putting forth as potential deacons at the Kanawha City Church of Christ are **Matt Barber**, **Doug Hartley**, **Carson Henley**, **and Pete Williams**. We thank these men for their willingness and desire to serve and we want to continue to pray for them and encourage them.

The process moving forward will look like this:

- January 7 Potential deacons presented to the congregation.
- January 7-21 The congregation will pray over these men and review their qualifications to be deacons.
 - * If someone feels that one of these men is not qualified to be a deacon, we want to encourage you to take the biblical approach and go talk to that man first.
 - * If after meeting with that man you still have an objection, then you are asked to bring the objection to the elders.
- After January 21 The elders will take some time to review any comments brought to them and work towards finalizing the deacon process.
- Upon completion of review the church will install new deacons to work alongside the existing
 ones.

We ask that you be in fervent prayer for these four men that are being considered as potential deacons, the current deacons, the leadership as a whole, and the entire church body. Thank you for your patience and support during this process.
