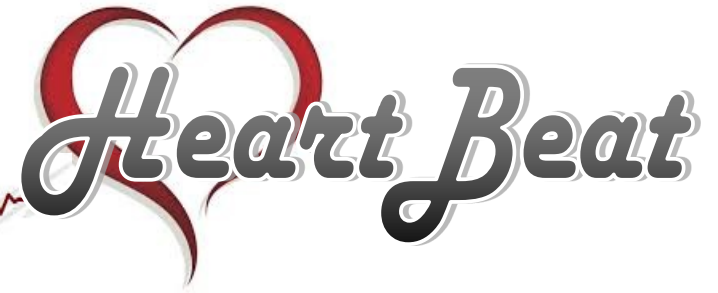

BUILDING FUND UPDATE

We recently became aware of some major repairs that need to be made to the roof over several portions of the building. After receiving three bids, the total estimated cost is \$38,820. At the time we signed the contract we made a deposit of \$19,410, which exhausted the total amount of money in the Building Fund YTD. The remaining balance to make these repairs is \$19,410. The elders are finalizing a plan on how to pay for this much needed work.
